Increase in School Dinner Price with Abm Catering

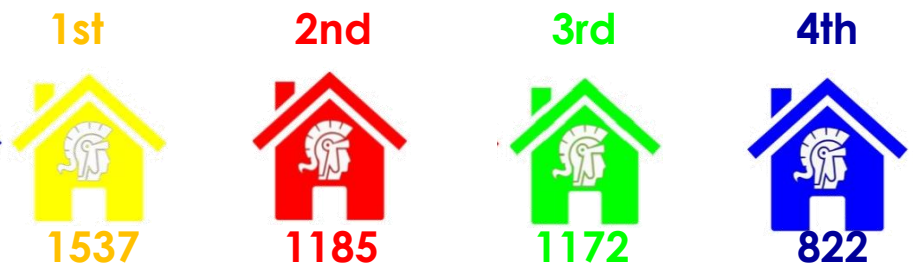

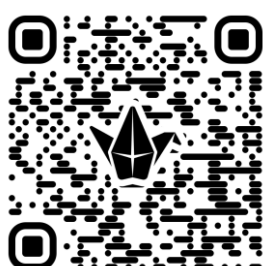
