## Homework at Hadrian

We are planning to update our homework policy by the end of the summer term, having collected as many views from our school community as possible.

### What should homework look like for Hadrian Academy children?

In 2018, the government of the time removed the specifications around how much homework should be given in primary schools, so there is no guidance to adhere to.

However, as educators we recognise the power of **practice** and **reinforcement** outside of the school day and the [EEF](#) report that completing regular homework does have a positive impact (+3 months.) However, in our busy lives we know that homework can be squeezed out or become a burden.

As a school, we have been trialling some new online resources to help with this and would like to reflect these in the update of our homework policy. We also recognise the impact it has on creating positive learning habits ahead of moving to secondary school.

It will be incredibly hard to suit everyone, but with your views we hope we can provide a policy which takes everyone's ideas into account.

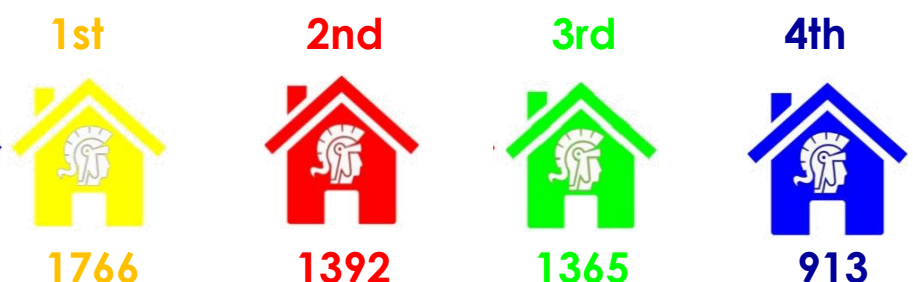

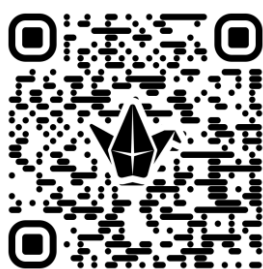
