Dear parents

Starting on Monday 24th February, all children who attend the **Cool Kids breakfast club and clubs before school** will need to enter school via the main reception doors. We have set up a bell system which works by families pressing the buzzer and notifying the Cool Kids Club staff that they have arrived. The doors will then be opened by a member of the Cool Kids Club and children will be able to enter school.

This has been put in place to improve the safety of the children and the school site.
